

Online Instructional Method Categories

<p>All Distance Learning (AD) 100% of the direct instruction of the course is delivered using some form of technology when the student and instructor are separated by time, space, or both. All special course components (exams, internships, practica, clinicals, labs, etc.) that cannot be completed online can be completed off-campus.</p>	<p>Primarily Distance Learning (PD) 80-99% of the direct instruction of the course is delivered using some form of technology when the student and instructor are separated by time, space, or both. (There is a requirement for the student to attend campus for a portion of the course.)</p>	<p>Hybrid (HB) 50-79% of the direct instruction of the course is delivered using some form of technology when the student and instructor are separated by time, space, or both.</p>	<p>Classroom (CL) Less than 50% of the direct instruction of the course is delivered using some form of technology when the student and instructor are separated by time, space, or both. (This designation can include activities that do not occur in a classroom (i.e. lab, internship, practica, clinical, etc.))</p>
